# The Village develops fiscal plans for the yearly maintenance of 13.42 centerline miles of roadway.

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## Three Primary Goals of Road Maintenance Program:

1. The goal is to achieve repaving of 10% of village roads every fiscal year.
2. Develop plans and budget appropriations for the year long maintenance of the village road system.
3. Manage the maintenance of stormwater collection system in compliance with MS4 regulations.

# MIDLAND AVENUE REHABILITATION

First expansion of the storm water system in the Village since 2010 to improve drainage on Midland Avenue.  
Every corner on Midland Avenue will be made handicap accessible.

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## COMPLETED WORK

### 2016 & 2017

- Every corner from Cedar Hill Ave to High Avenue has been made handicap accessible.
- Selected driveway aprons replaced.
- Complete repaving from Cedar Hill Ave to High Ave.
- Storm water catch basins added between High Ave and Haven Ct.
- Curbs replaced on Midland – between High Ave and Haven Ct.

### SPRING 2018 WORK TO BE COMPLETED

- Remaining handicap corner construction
- Mill and repave road from High Avenue to northern border with Upper Nyack

# BROADWAY STREETScape PROJECT (TAP)

\$3,087,000 Project funded by the Federal Highway Administration through the NYSDOT

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Reconstruction of sidewalks, street lights and amenities along Broadway- from Cedar Hill Ave to Upper Nyack border.

Development of a bike path to connect with the South Nyack Esposito Trail and the new bridge shared use path.

Summer 2018 anticipated start of construction
