RESOLUTION OF THE NYACK VILLAGE BOARD DECLARING A NEGATIVE DECLARATION ON THE VILLAGE OF NYACK LOCAL WATERFRONT REVITALIZATION PROGRAM UPDATE UNDER THE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT.

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2017, the Village directed its planning consultants, BFJ Planning (“BFJ”) to initiate work on the Village of Nyack Local Waterfront Revitalization Program (LWRP) update; and

WHEREAS, BFJ met three times with the LWRP Steering Committee to discuss the proposed LWRP update and developed a draft for the Board’s consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Village held two public workshops to gather input from the community about policies and projects that the Village should prioritize in the waterfront area; and

WHEREAS, the proposed LWRP update is classified as a Type I action under Part 617.4 (b)(2) of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQR”); and

WHEREAS, the Village Board directed planning BFJ to complete a full Environmental Assessment Form (EAF) pursuant to SEQR, and said EAF was submitted to the Village board dated August 10, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board declared itself lead agency for this action and authorized circulation of the EAF and draft LWRP to adjacent municipalities and Rockland County, and set a public hearing for September 28, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Nyack Village Board hereby adopts the attached Negative Declaration with respect to the Proposed Action and issues a finding that, based upon information contained in the full EAF, the proposed action will not have any significant adverse impacts on the environment, no environmental impact statement (EIS) needs to be prepared and the SEQRA process is complete.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
