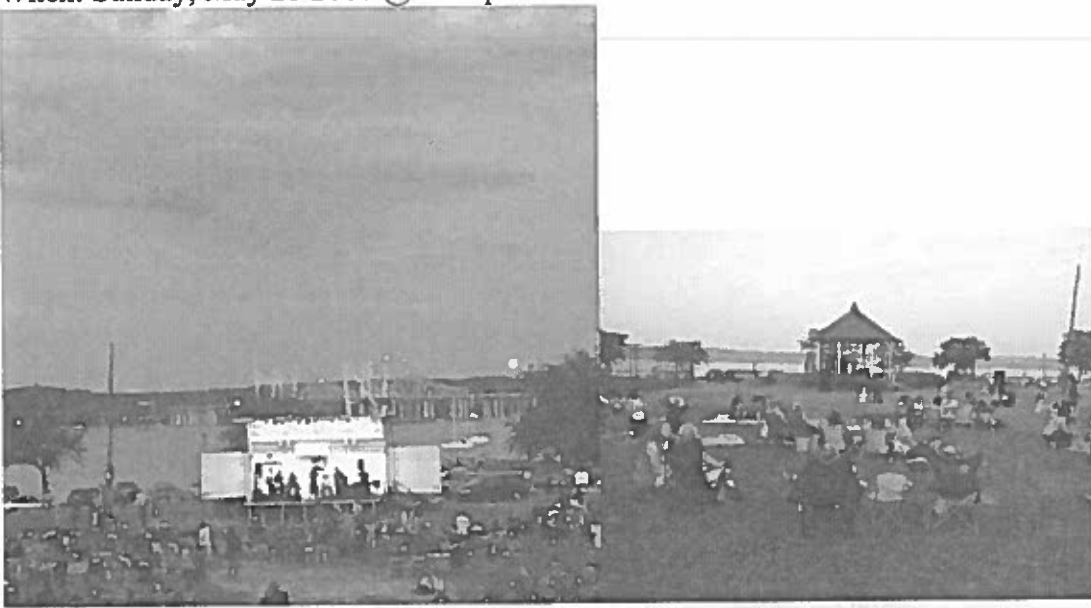

Where: Memorial Park, lower level, on the Hudson River (picture attached) or the viewing platform (picture attached)

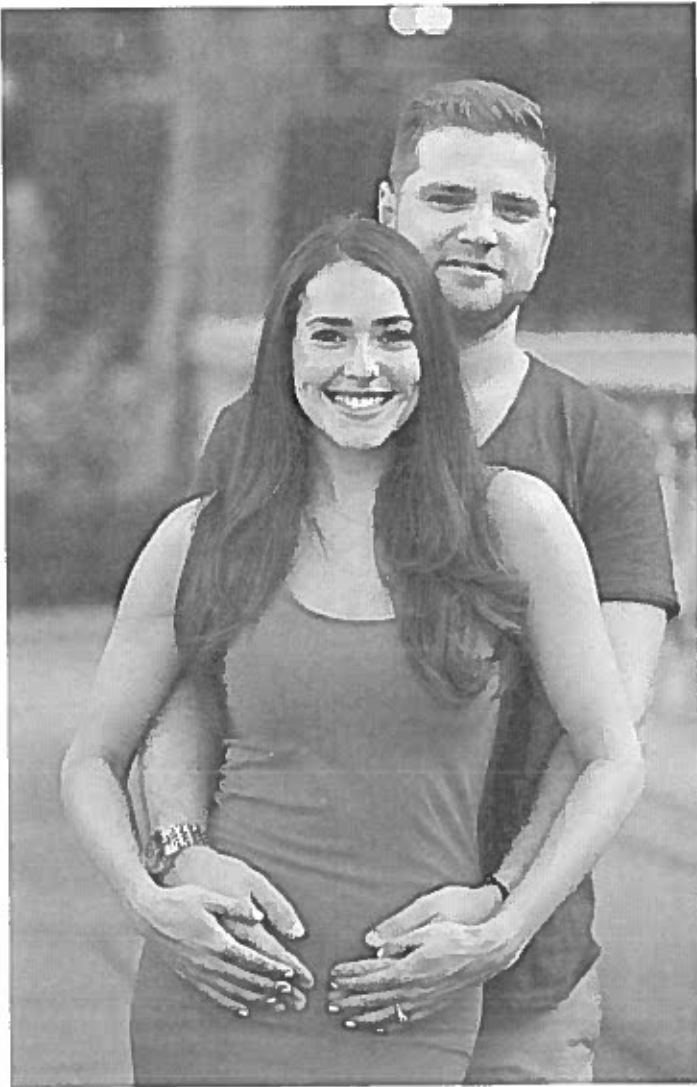
