1. **Nyack Joint Fire District Fire Boat** – The NJFD is requesting the use of a Village marina boat slip throughout the year. Their proposal would require the installation of a “bubbler” for the winter months. The NJFD will provide and install the “bubbler” at their cost.
  
2. **CDBG Committee Member Volunteers** – The Board of Trustees has opened the request for volunteers to participate in the Citizen Advisory Committee for the CDBG FY 2018. Several citizens have offered to serve and have submitted their names for Board consideration.
  
3. **First Ave Tree/Sidewalk** - The owner of 63 North Broadway has asked that we review and discuss the village tree that is impacting the sidewalk on the south side of their home on First Ave. The tree has pushed up the sidewalk through time and pavement has been used to mitigate the rippling of the sidewalk surface. The owner is asking that we 1) remove the tree so they can put in new concrete sidewalks. Tree removal estimate is +/- \$1,600.00, or 2) that the Village take possession of the tree and sidewalk, and the Village indemnifies the homeowner if the Board decides to salvage the tree and create a walkable and safe sidewalk.
  
4. **Jack & Jill of America, Inc.** – Nathalie Riobe-Taylor met with Village Staff to discuss the proposed Hoodies March scheduled for Saturday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2018. The Village Administrator will discuss the proposal for Board review and consideration. The march would begin at 2:00pm; assemble at North Mill Street & Jackson Avenue; travel east on Jackson Avenue; north on Franklin Avenue; east on Main Street; south on Broadway; and enter the Nyack Center from South Broadway for an event.

5. **Parking Signage** – The Village’s parking department staff and Village Administrator would like to present two parking regulation changes that we believe will enhance parking capabilities in the Village’s Atrpoee parking lot, and on Bridge Street.
