Playground Fence: The vendor who was going to build the fence has decided not to accept the project, so a new vendor needs to be chosen. This is a high priority; Jim and Carolyn will reach out to prospective vendors, as will Melody Partrick, the Nyack recreation director.

Gazebo. The Village is making contingency plans to have a portable stage ready in Memorial Park, for events such as Mostly Music, should the new gazebo not be ready in time.

Graffiti: The issue of an increasing amount of graffiti in town, on building and recycling containers, was discussed, with possible cleanups to be arranged.

Recycling bins in Memorial Park: There was a request from the Village that the Parks Commission review the design for the new recycling containers in Memorial Park. There was a question of what will happen to the current cement garbage receptacles.

Water Fountain: Marcy Denker told the Commission that the water fountain on the upper level of Memorial Park would be replaced. Design and timing will be discussed.

Meeting ended early at 7p.m. so commissioners could attend the Master Comprehensive Plan meeting at the Nyack Center.
