What's the status of the gazebo? Village received grant for \$10,000, but project is much more expensive than originally imagines, close to \$250,00 including base structure, Polygon structure, landscaping etc. The project is being rebid.

Water play area in the Memorial Park. The Nyack Parks Commission will work with the Nyack Park Conservancy, which has taken on a new children's water play area as its next major project. The current sprinkler system is old and does not drain properly and backs up, sometimes flooding adjacent areas of the playground. To keep it going requires constant repair, and last year it was vandalized several times. The Village would like it moved a bit farther away from the steps, and new electrical would have to be included.

Water fountain on upper Memorial Park. Village has located the water fountain donated by Commissioner Bert Hughes. It was also suggested that the water fountain near the restrooms be redone with a more solid base to protect it against breakage.

LED Lighting in the Park. Last year the Parks Commission had met with a lighting company to discuss new lighting in Memorial park both for better energy efficiency and coverage, as well as for security. The Village's Environmental Committee has taken on the issue; the Parks Commission will discuss the effort with Marcy Denker at the Green Desk.

Parks recreation programs. Jim Willcox will reach out to Melody Partrick, the Village's rec director, to discuss.

Status of Tan/Wax property and bridge over the inlet. Question as to the status of this plan, which requires an easement from the property owners. Bridge would join the northern section of Memorial Park with the marina. Village's attorney.

Relocation of Memorial Park parking to marina. Question as to what was happening with this element of the revised waterfront comprehensive master plan. The Village reports that it is in preliminary stages, being reviewed by engineers.

Question about the Nyack Seaport blocking off the street into the parking area. Village will have to research.
